


#### SINGAPORE'S COMPETITIONS AND AWARDS PROGRAM

The Design Singapore Initiative (DSI) invited international awards such as **red dot** and the **World Architecture Festival**, and international design events such as **Maison et Objet** to be based in or hosted in Singapore.

To encourage their designers to develop a portfolio of awards, the DSI, in cooperation with businesses, shouldered half the entry fees of Singapore designers to these competitions during the first three years of its program.

The DSI also organized local and international competitions, such as the **President's Design Award**, the nation's highest honour for its designers, and the **Singapore Design Award**, to profile exemplary designs in Asia.

- A global ASEAN.

# COMPETITORS ON THE SAME TEAM

The National Competitiveness Council of the Philippines (NCCP) got it right when they said we must think about the ASEAN Economic Community (AEC) as "we/us," not "they/them." It is a difficult paradigm to shift to because back, front, and center of people's minds is that there are bound to be losers in such a community, and one of them could be us. As Japanese economist Norio Usui told his audience at an NCCP dialogue, *Getting Ready for the ASEAN Economic Community*, "With ASEAN integration, if you are not strong enough, you will die."

Ironically, the secret to not dying is to whole-heartedly embrace that which threatens to kill us. How does that work? Dr. Cielito Habito of USAID TRADE Project says, by losing the *kanya-kanya* mentality and embracing instead "coopetition," businesses, industries and our country will thrive in a borderless ASEAN economy.

Coopetition means complementation rather than competition: each ASEAN country providing goods and services that complement one another intra-industry, to achieve efficiency and stronger interdependence, thus resulting in stronger regional cohesion, harmony and peace, says Habito. If we can achieve intra-industry trade, an integrated ASEAN will achieve the economies of scale to enable our region to compete in the global marketplace.

There are other benefits to integration. If we see each other as members of the same team, then technology sharing will be genuine, improve efficiency, lower costs and increase productivity. All these translate to higher incomes and inclusive growth. Aside from the free flow of goods, professional services, skilled labor, investment and capital, having one competitive ASEAN economy will enable better enforcement of consumer protection, intellectual property rights, rationalized taxation and e-commerce.

What the Philippines would really gain is a coherent approach to external economic relations. These benefits and more, says Habito, far outweigh the downsides to integration, which are: greater vulnerability to supply chain disruptions and possible inequitable growth across ASEAN member-states.

The thing is, it is *inequitable commitment* more than anything else that will result in inequitable growth. Habito warns that "trade protection," the knee-jerk and "nationalistic" reaction to integration, will "actually be self-penalizing."

Local architecture and design professionals led by their respective Boards and professional organizations need to take on the perspective of industry and business; and study AEC opportunities, strengthen their financial and overall business management capabilities, and formulate strategies to serve as overall guiding force.

While the ideal AEC scenario is one of coopetition, Singapore in the meantime hasn't waited around for its neighbors to level up. They have forged full speed at boosting the country's global competitiveness, without us. But then, that's not a bad thing because when we finally come around to "do the right thing," as Habito says, we will have one strong neighbor on our team.
